



Interior Design Program Laptop Requirements

Overview

All students accepted to the INDS Program for Fall 2025 are required to have a laptop meeting or exceeding the following specifications throughout the course of their degree completion. In the INDS Program, the most current technology is used to better prepare students for their professional design careers. We use software programs that demand high-performance processing power, random access memory (short-term memory), and graphic capabilities (a video/graphics card). Essential Software in the Interior Design Program

Courses may require additional software announced by instructors through the course syllabus. Auburn University offers free student versions of the software for Adobe and Autodesk. Where software is not free, the department equips for students in the semester where it is used. The college will provide cloud computing for student use.

- SketchUp Pro
- Enscape (an advanced rendering software plug in to SketchUp and Revit)
- Twinmotion for Ravit
- Adobe Creative Cloud (e.g., Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign)

Notes:

- 1. Apple products with the M4 chips are <u>incompatible</u> with the necessary software. <u>Macs should not be considered</u> due to the need to use software like Autodesk Revit which is PC based only.
- 2. Students also have the option to use a virtual machine for software that may require more capabilities (i.e., Enscape). To use the virtual machine, students must have a reliable internet connection and a computer with the Windows operating system (at least meeting the minimum requirements mentioned above).
- 3. Google Chromebook and other lightweight computers and tablets are <u>NOT capable</u> of running the necessary software.
- 4. Regular backups are highly suggested using external drives in addition to cloud storages.
